For this write, choose one of the chapter/ stories as the inspiration for your writing. You might want to reread/skim the chapter in its entirety before write.

- If you choose "Stockings", the entry should be about some aspect of superstitions. Write about superstitions in general, why people have them, your superstitions, or some other related topic
- If you choose "Church", you need to select a quote from the chapter as the springboard for your entry. There are lots of good quotes and questions about religion. Why things happen to good people, etc. State the quote first.
- If you choose "The Man I Killed", the journal entry should be about a life-changing moment or event. How did this moment or event change you, your outlooks, beliefs, how you see yourself and/or the world around you? Try and be as specific as possible when describing this person or incident, like O'Brien is describing the man he killed.

Restrictions:

Nothing larger than 11 or 12 point font

Use either Ariel, Calibri, or Times Roman

In your title: The First Letter of Every Word Is Capitalized

Avoid using "Headers". It tends to add confusion

Whichever topic you select, your paper MUST be at least 17 lines long (minimum)

This assignment must be typed, MLA Format. Try to print your paper before class starts.

Never use "you" or "your" in writing except if the word is used as part of a quote/conversation.

Never write: "I think...", "I believe...", "I feel...", "In my opinion...", "In conclusion..."
